THE EXODUS THE TEN COMMANDMENTS THE PROMISED LAND

The deliverance of the Hebrew people from the hand of the Egyptian pharaoh (most likely Amenhotep II, pharaoh of Egypt from 1427 to 1401 BC) is one of the most famous stories of antiquity. Warner Brothers has recently announced plans for a major epic entitled *Gods and Kings* while director Ridley Scott is pondering *Exodus*, a remake of his own.

Beyond the miraculous and unforgettable parting of the Red Sea, the horrific might of the Ten Plagues and the feeding of the people in the desert, there is the story of the faithfulness of God as He continues to reveal Himself to not only the Hebrews and the Egyptians, but to all people throughout history.

God's laws to protect and maintain health and a civil society, and instruction in worship are all seen in the laws He gave His people on how to live the full and obedient life.

And the terrible wandering for 40 years in the desert is a reminder to all of how God hates sin and will punish and discipline those who disobey Him.
