

Approximately 2000 years after the Creation and subsequent Fall of Man and 400 years after the Flood, the world was lapsed into idolatry and wickedness. Ur, where Abraham and his family lived, was in Babylonia, a center of many false gods and goddesses. Nimrod, who exalted himself against God by building the Tower of Babel, was the chief deity. The more common name was Marduk, which became identical with Bel. The moon-god and moon-goddess practices of the region were steeped in immorality. Abraham was a righteous man, not an idolater, but one who believed in the one God who created and ruled the earth. Out of Ur God called Abraham to the land of Canaan. His name comes to use through the ages as not only the founder of the Hebrew nation but also as synonymous with great faith. God gave to Abraham three great promises:

- 1 He and his descendants would inherit the land of Canaan
- 2 His descendants would become a great nation
- 3 Through him all nations would be blessed

The son of Abraham, Isaac, was a miraculous birth - born to his aged parents well after their childbearing years. Isaac served as the center point of one of the hardest tests of faith any man can endure — the sacrifice of a son. This Old Testament story stands out and serves as a foreshadowing of the future time when God would offer up His only son to death for the sin of mankind. His older brother Ishmael, born as a result of Abraham's temporary lapse in faith, became the father of the modern Arabic nations.


Jacob, the son of Isaac, became the founder of the Israelite nation and God changed his name to Israel to reflect that fact. His twelve sons became the twelve tribes of Israel. God confirmed to Jacob in dreams that the land of Canaan would belong to his descendants.

Joseph, the last Patriarch, serves as a testimony to the sovereignty of God in working out all things to our ultimate good and to His glory. Sharing dreams and visions given him by God only resulted in conflict with his family and Joseph being sold into slavery. Keeping his integrity and trust in God's purpose, even when falsely accused, landed Joseph in an Egyptian prison. But this prison only served as a launching pad for God to raise Joseph up as the second highest ruler in Egypt in a great deliverance that saved thousands of lives and preserved the Hebrew nation and the Messianic line.
